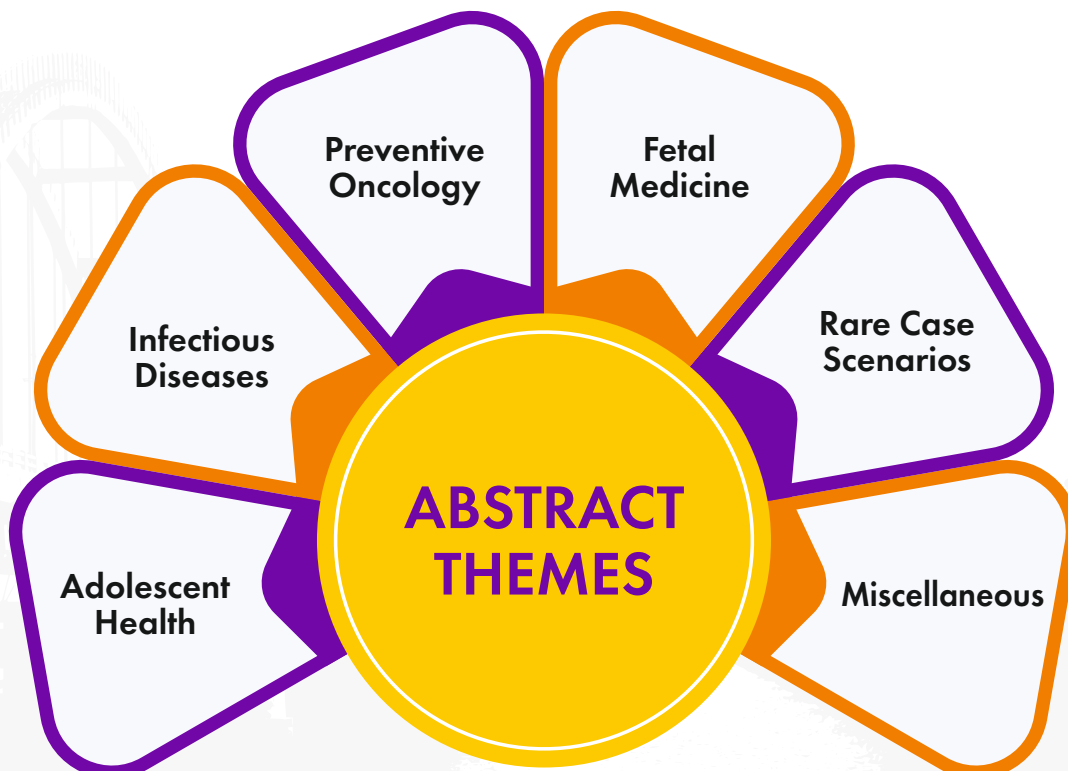

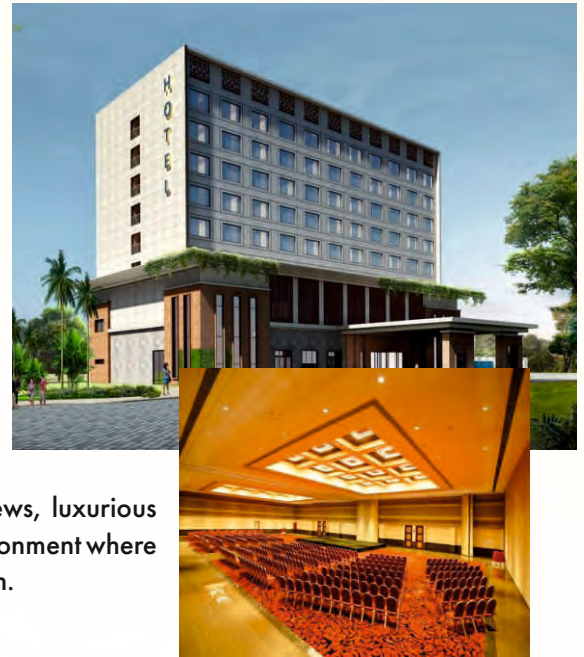

RAJAMAHENDRAVARAM

Rajahmundry, officially known as Rajamahendravaram, is a historic city in Andhra Pradesh situated on the banks of the Godavari River. Founded in 1022 CE by the Chalukya ruler Raja Raja Narendra, it once served as the first capital of the Telugu kingdoms. The city holds immense cultural and literary significance, being the birthplace of the Telugu language and literature, and is often referred to as the “Cultural Capital of Andhra Pradesh.”

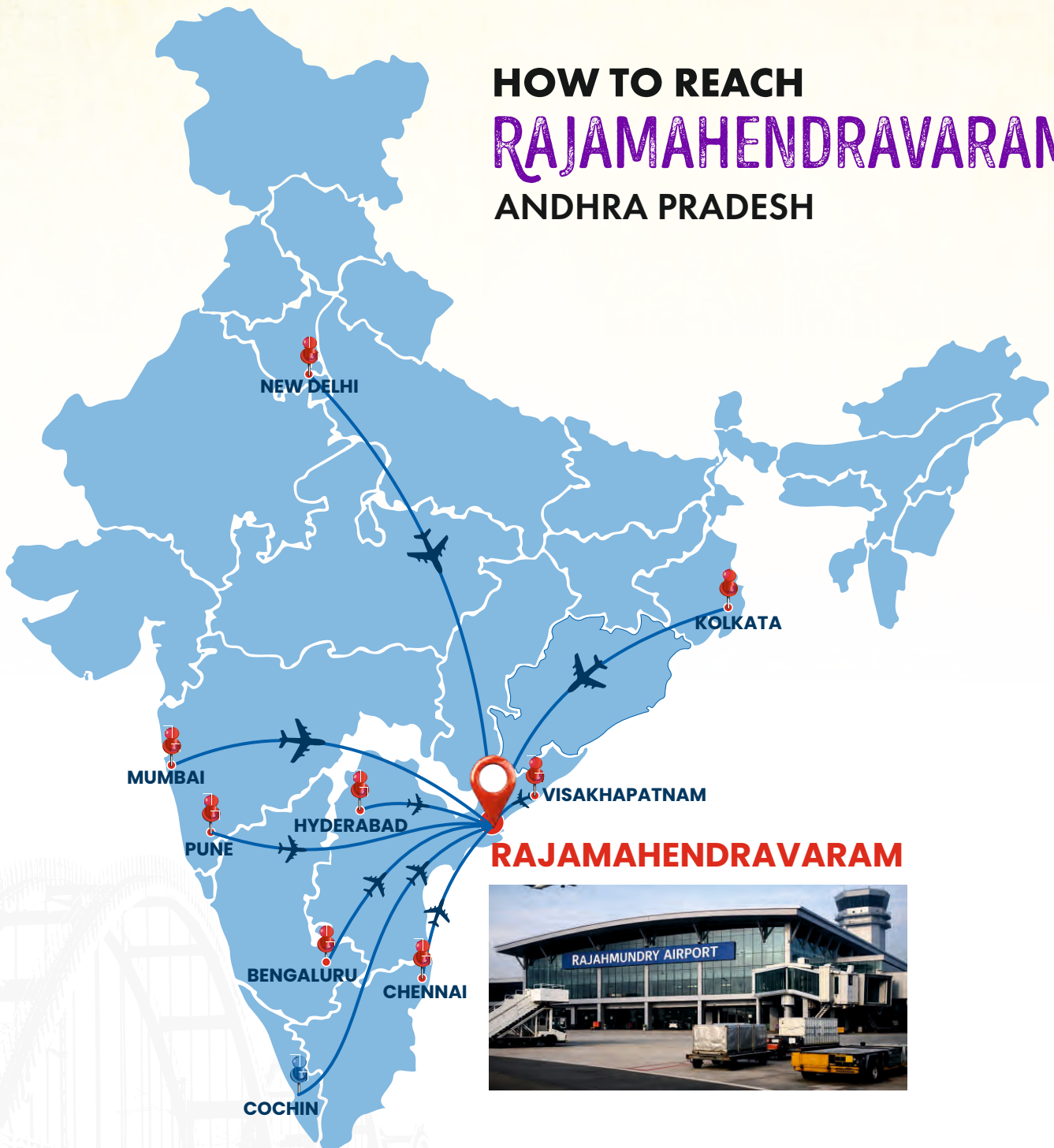
Rich in heritage and tradition, Rajahmundry is known for its ancient temples, scenic ghats, and vibrant festivals that reflect the spirit of Telugu culture. The city’s timeless charm lies in its harmonious blend of spirituality, art, and history, making it a destination that appeals to both devotees and travelers alike. The ideal time to visit is between October and March, when the weather is pleasant and ideal for sightseeing and cultural exploration.



Rajahmundry also offers a distinctive local shopping experience, famous for its traditional silk sarees with golden and silver borders, handicrafts, and gold and silver jewellery markets. Its local bazaars showcase authentic handmade products that highlight the region’s artisanal skill. The city is well-connected through the Rajahmundry Airport (RJA) in Madhurapudi, and by extensive road and rail networks, ensuring convenient travel for visitors.



HOW TO REACH RAJAMAHENDRAVARAM ANDHRA PRADESH



by Air

Rajahmundry Airport (RJA), located approximately 18 km from the city, offers direct flights from Mumbai, Bengaluru, and Delhi. Passengers from Kolkata and Pune can conveniently access Rajamahendravaram via connecting flights through Hyderabad or Chennai.

by Rail

Rajahmundry Railway Station (RJY) is a major station on the Howrah–Chennai main line, with direct connectivity to Hyderabad, Chennai, Kolkata, Mumbai, Bengaluru, and Visakhapatnam.

by Road

Well-connected via National Highway 16 (NH-16), Rajamahendravaram has excellent road connectivity to Vijayawada, Visakhapatnam, Hyderabad, and Chennai, supported by frequent APSRTC and private bus services.



PLACES TO VISIT IN RAJAMAHENDRAVARAM

PAPIKONDALU (60 KM)

A stunning hill range along the Godavari River, famous for scenic boat cruises through lush green valleys and tribal regions. Often referred to as the “Kashmir of Andhra Pradesh,” it is one of the most picturesque destinations in the region.

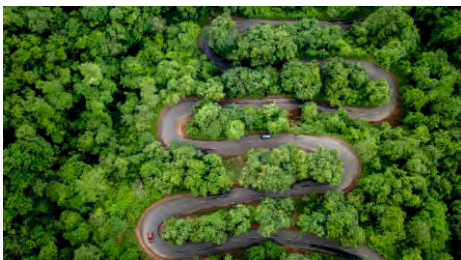


ANNAVARAM (79 KM)

Annavaram is a well-known pilgrimage town in Andhra Pradesh, famous for the Sri Veera Venkata Satyanarayana Swamy Temple. Located on Ratnagiri Hill, it offers a serene spiritual atmosphere along with panoramic views of the Godavari.

KADIYAM NURSERIES (18 KM)

Kadiyam is renowned across India for its extensive plant nurseries, flower gardens, and horticulture industry. The region hosts hundreds of nurseries spread across thousands of acres, offering a wide variety of ornamental plants, fruit saplings, medicinal plants, and avenue trees.

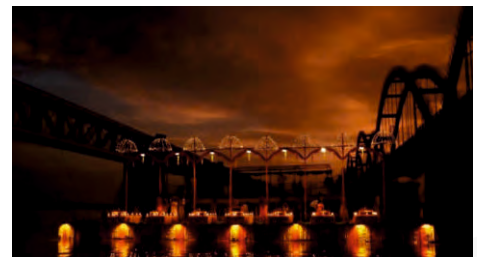


MAREDUMILLI (80 KM)

Nestled amidst lush forests, Maredumilli is known for its scenic beauty, misty hills, and waterfalls. Popularized by films like Pushpa 2: The Rule, it offers a perfect blend of nature, adventure, and tranquility—making it an ideal weekend getaway.

GODAVARI HARATHI (4 KM)

Godavari Harathi is a spiritual ritual where lamps are offered to the sacred Godavari River accompanied by prayers and chants. It symbolizes devotion, gratitude, and the deep connection between nature and faith.

- ❖ **Godavari Bridge** (3 km) – A prominent landmark across the Godavari River, near the historic Dowleswaram Barrage built by Sir Arthur Cotton
- ❖ **Pushkar Ghat** (2 km) – A sacred bathing ghat on the Godavari
- ❖ **Old Godavari Railway Bridge** (3 km) – An iconic heritage rail bridge
- ❖ **ISKCON Rajahmundry** (4 km) – A peaceful spiritual retreat
- ❖ **Pattiseema Temple** (35 km) – A temple located on a scenic river island
- ❖ **Dwaraka Tirumala** (95 km) – Known as Chinna Tirupati
- ❖ **Pithapuram Puruhutika Devi Temple** (70 km) – A revered Shakti Peetham
- ❖ **Ryali Temple** (40 km) – Famous for the unique Jaganmohini Kesava idol
- ❖ **Vadapalli Temple** (50 km) – Known as the Tirumala of Konaseema
- ❖ **Gudisa Hills** (90 km) – A beautiful sunrise viewpoint
- ❖ **Polavaram Project** (45 km) – A major irrigation project on the Godavari River
- ❖ **Coringa Wildlife Sanctuary** (75 km) – A rich mangrove ecosystem with diverse wildlife
- ❖ **Antharvedi** (130 km) – A serene temple at the confluence of the Godavari River and the Bay of Bengal
- ❖ **Kandukuri Veeresalingam House** (2 km) – Historic residence of a renowned social reformer

Pancharama Kshetras

Located within 40–180 km, these five sacred Shiva temples are major pilgrimage destinations:

- ❖ **Samarlakota** (50 km) – Kumararama Temple
- ❖ **Draksharamam** (45 km) – Bhimeswara Swamy Temple & Manikyamba Shakti Peetham
- ❖ **Bhimavaram** (80 km) – Somarama Temple
- ❖ **Palakollu** (90 km) – Ksheerarama Temple
- ❖ **Amaravati** (180 km) – Amararam Temple and Buddhist heritage site
